Accessible lodges are registered as NAS M3 Assisted Living standard with a

ground floor twin bed room with electric bed, wet room style bathroom with level entry roll in shower with grab rails and grab rails at the toilet and extended tap handles on the sink, there is also a living/dining room and superbly equipped kitchen with lowered kitchen surfaces, upstairs offers a king size master bedroom with ensuite bathroom, a further bathroom and twin bedroom.
